Frequently Asked Questions

Do you have to apply FrameGuard™ treatment to end-cuts?

No; you maintain the warranty without the treatment of end cuts.

Does the green pigment “seep” through drywall?

No; the color pigment is for identification only and does not seep through drywall materials.

Can you paint FrameGuard™ treated lumber?

Yes; standard painting practices apply.

Does FrameGuard™ cause fasteners to corrode?

No; tests conducted show corrosion levels to be comparable to those of untreated lumber

Does FrameGuard™ treated lumber give off an odor?

No; not only does it not give off an odor, FrameGuard® treatment has been Greenguard® Indoor Air Quality Certified.

Do you have to use protective clothing and respirators when handling FrameGuard™ treated lumber?

FrameGuard™ treated lumber has a very similar MSDS sheets as untreated lumber. MSDS sheets for both Untreated and FrameGuard™ treated lumber recommend the use of gloves and a respirator when cutting and handling.

Does the FrameGuard™ coating affect the strength of the lumber?

A test conducted by Timber Products Inspection showed that FrameGuard™ coating has no significant effect on strength of lumber and other wood products.

Can you apply the treatment to engineered wood products?

Yes; the FrameGuard™ coating is a topical treatment, not pressure treated.
